



IOWA DRIVER'S RIGHTS CARD

IF YOU ARE STOPPED BY THE POLICE, WILL YOU KNOW YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS?

The purpose of this Driver's Rights Card, provided by Dickey & Campbell Law Firm, P.L.C., is to help educate members of the public on how to assert their rights under Iowa law. Carry the following Driver's Rights Card at all times in each automobile you own along with your registration, and proof of insurance—together in a single envelope. If you are stopped by the police, hand the officer the envelope with all three records along with your driver's license. Let the card speak for you. Do not read it to the officer. Remember, the police have power, but their power is limited by your rights if you assert them.

This Driver's Rights Card is intended solely to educate the public about their legal rights during a traffic stop. It is not legal advice and should not be understood as creating any attorney-client relationship. It is not intended to help individuals avoid detection or prosecution for violations of the law. The safest way to avoid a drunk-driving arrest is to drink responsibly and have a designated driver.

1. I tender my driver's license, proof of insurance and vehicle registration.
2. I immediately **INVOKE MY RIGHT TO AN ATTORNEY** and request that I be allowed to call Attorney **Gary Dickey Jr.** at 515.205.8841 or **Angela Campbell** at 515.321.8504. If they are not available, I request to call another attorney or a relative.
3. **I DO NOT CONSENT TO A SEARCH** of my person, vehicle, or any other property without my written permission.
4. I invoke my **RIGHT TO REMAIN SILENT**, and do not wish to make any statements, nor do I wish to answer any questions. If you believe I have committed a traffic violation, please issue a citation and allow me to leave, otherwise I will assume I am under arrest.
5. As is my right under Iowa law, **I CHOOSE NOT TO TAKE ANY SO-CALLED FIELD SOBRIETY TESTS** including **A PRELIMINARY BREATH TEST**. I reserve the right to make a decision about subsequent chemical testing after I am given a reasonable opportunity to contact my attorney.
6. I also demand that I be videotaped by the use of police video equipment, both at the roadside and at the police station, and that all such tapes be preserved.
